From the Vicar's Desk...

Dearly Beloved In Christ,

The first month of another New Year has passed.

God's abundant grace was poured into our lives. It was eventful and blessed. It was a time of introspection and prospection through various General Body Meetings and committee meetings of the Sub-Organizations. Thank you to all secretaries and treasurers for all your sincere service and commitment for preparation of Annual Reports and End of Year Financial statements.

I am so happy and thankful to the Youths and Young Adults (YAYA) Fellowship of our parish for organizing a blessed retreat at Refreshing Mountains, PA from January 13-15, 2023. We had 69 participants, and it was a refreshing time for all the participants to connect with God and their fellow brothers and sisters. We were highly blessed to have Rev. Larry Varghese and Rev. Jess M. George as the leaders. I appreciate all the coordinators, conveners, and especially the General Convener, Mr. Saji George for all your efforts.

The month of February is the time of spiritual rejuvenation. According to the liturgical calendar of the church, we have two Lenten experiences: 1) Nineveh Lent (3 Day Lent), 2) Great Lent (50 Days Lent). The Nineveh Lent, focuses on the word of God that renews and rejuvenates us. The word of God proclaimed before the people of Nineveh through the prophet Jonah prompted the whole nation into repentance and confession. We read in the Bible, “When God saw what they did and how they turned from their evil ways, he relented and did not bring on them the destruction he had threatened.” (Jonah 3:10).

The 128th Maramon Convention, the biggest Christian convention in all of Asia, begins on February 12, 2023. It is a festival of the Word. When we look into the conventions history, there are a number of examples of how the proclaimed Word challenged the people toward repentance and renewal.

For instance, the use of tobacco and paan was a way of life in Kerala during the first half of the 20th Century. It was an essential item at so-

cial events such as marriages and other family gatherings. It was a common sight to have people attend the Maramon Convention meetings with these items in their pockets. During one meeting, Dr. Stanley Jones, one of the convention speakers, urged people to refrain from the use of tobacco products. After the session, the convention participants decided to bury their tobacco (which they were carrying) in the sand bed where they gathered. This became a spiritual wave all over Kerala.

This year we are fortunate to have the live stream of the convention sessions through the DSMC YouTube Channel. Please make use of the facility provided to us to participate online for the convention sessions.

After the Maramon Convention we enter into the Great Lent with this renewed experience. I urge all my beloved parish members to prioritize the 50 days for prayer, meditation and Bible study. Beginning the second week in Lent (Feb. 27 onward), Sandhya Namaskaram (Evening Prayer) are arranged via Zoom meetings from Monday through Friday at 7.00pm. Sub-organizations are assigned for various roles.

Our parish Annual General Body Meeting for the year 2022 is arranged on Feb. 12, 2023 immediately after the Holy Communion service. The election of the representatives to the Diocesan Assembly and to the Sabha Prathinidhi Mandalam will also take place during the meeting. Seek your prayers and cooperation.

I have applied for a short leave from February 20-25, 2023. In my absence, Rev. T. K. John will be in charge. In case of any emergencies, please contact the office-bearers.
